Mini Meat Loaf Sheet-Pan Meal

Ingredients

½ teaspoon salt

2 large eggs, lightly beaten 1 cup tomato juice 34 cup quick cooking oats 1/2 teaspoon garlic salt, divided

½ teaspoon garlic salt, divided
 ¼ teaspo
 ¼ cup finely chopped onion
 3 tablesp
 3 large potatoes, peeled and cut into 1/2 inch pieces

1 ½ pounds lean ground beef (90% lean) ¼ cup ketchup

1/4 teaspoon pepper, divided 3 tablespoons brown sugar

1 pound fresh asparagus, trimmed and halved

1 teaspoon prepared mustard

3 tablespoons olive oil, divided

1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 425°. In a large bowl, combine eggs, tomato juice, oats, onion and salt. Add beef; Mix lightly but thoroughly. Shape into six 4x2-1/2in. loaves; place on a sheet pan or in a large shallow roasting pan. Combine ketchup, brown sugar, mustard and nutmeg; brush over loaves.
- 2. Combine potatoes with 2 tablespoons oil, ¼ teaspoon garlic salt and 1/8 teaspoon pepper; toss to coat. Add to pan in a single layer. Bake loaves and potatoes 25 minutes.
- Combine asparagus with remaining 1 tablespoon oil, ¼ teaspoon garlic salt and 1/8 teaspoon pepper; toss to coat. Add to pan. Bake until a thermometer inserted into meat loaves reads 160° and vegetables are tender, 15-20 minutes. Let stand 5 minutes before serving.
